BIRTHDAY ASSEMBLY, MONDAY 18TH DECEMBER: An extra-long assembly to celebrate with those children whose birthday falls between 17th December and 7th January. Parents of these children are welcome to join us. *Please note – due to "human error", we mistakenly did some of the birthdays last week! If your child has a birthday on the dates mentioned, and they said they already had their assembly WE WILL CELEBRATE AGAIN!! So please come to the assembly!*

CHRISTMAS ASSEMBLY, TUESDAY 19TH DECEMBER AT 9.05AM (YEAR ONE PARENTS INVITED): Year One parents are invited to join us for this special assembly, where the year one children will be leading the singing and helping out Miss Sands as she tells the story of the nativity and Christmas traditions (please wait in the playground until the children are all in class, then you will be welcomed into the school hall for the assembly at 9.05am). ABSENCES AT THE END OF TERM: As always, absence is closely monitored. We know some families like to go away for the festive season and choose to leave before the end of term, however the children will be missing out on important learning (and festivities!) which will continue to the end of term. Families who leave for the holidays early, maybe fined. In all cases parents must ask for permission from Miss Sands and it will only be authorised in exceptional circumstances. If your child is off sick next week, we will need some sort of proof that they are at home rather than on holiday.

SPIRIT OF THE WILD WORKSHOP IN JANUARY: Each year we welcome a host of animals into school through Spirit of the Wild – Ben and Hannah bring animals into school and work with each class to not only show the children live animals (in past years this has included holding some of them, watching owls fly and racing the tortoise!) but also tell them all about the different animal groups, and their features and habitats. It is tailored for each year group, so children who have seen them before will get new information to build on the teaching from last year.

This is a hugely popular workshop, and an important part of the school year and reinforces work in the classroom. We will therefore be asking parents for a donation of £5 per child to cover the cost. Although the event is in January, we are aware that money at this time of year can go up and down, so to help our parents (and maximise donations) we are going to open the donations early next week so parents can pay anytime up to the middle of January when it suits them.
