**CHANGE IN LUNCH ARRANGEMENTS:** We would like to remind parents that children can only change once each half term between school and packed lunches, and that on all occasions you must notify the office in writing with at least three days' notice.

The lunch numbers are carefully monitored and we need to ensure that the kitchen are preparing the right number of meals and that all children are eating lunch.

**PARENT CONSULTATION BOOKINGS:** We will have these ready on Parentmail by the end of next week to book your meeting with your child's teacher on either Tuesday 12<sup>th</sup> March or Thursday 14<sup>th</sup> March between 3.30 – 6.30pm. The appointments will be 10 minutes long and take place in person in your child's classroom. Before they go live you will receive a Parentmail with instructions on how to book your appointment, followed by an invitation to book an appointment.
